



Global Business Innovation Programme – 3 stages

A GBIP comprises three main elements:

- Preparation
- Market Visit
- Exploiting the opportunity

Preparation includes the cohort being briefed by sector & market experts, including being advised on the cultural aspects of conducting business inmarket.

Delegates receive help to find partners & arrange meetings in country and be advised on commercial best practice & IP.
