Cyber security skills in the UK labour market 2022 report

 DCMS published its <u>annual report into cyber security skills in the UK labour market</u>. The report found that UK businesses continue to lack staff with the technical skills, incident response skills and governance skills needed to manage their cyber security. This included 51% of companies having a basic skills gap and being unable to carry out the kinds of basic tasks laid out in the governmentendorsed <u>Cyber</u>
