Running until the 31st of March 2025

Made Smarter is aimed at connecting 'makers' to digital tools that they can utilise to transform the way they work.

The programme will grow eligible businesses through emerging digital technology and help them to:

- Cut costs
- Go to market faster
- Reduce downtime



Who can join Made Smarter?

- Manufacturing and Engineering sector.
- Small or medium-sized enterprise with fewer than 250 employees.
- Turnover of less than £50 million, or a balance sheet total of less than £43 million.
- Trading in the West Midlands -Coventry & Warwickshire, Greater Birmingham & Solihull, The Marches, Stoke-on-Trent & Staffordshire, The Black Country and Worcestershire.
- Standard subsidy control regime rules apply



 - £5 million turnover
- DTS Visit- part of pre-screening
- Listen to business challenges and create a snapshot of current processes
- Diagnostic report created for WMG/MTC with client approval

Support Cohorts

MTC is a Research & Technology Organisation (Catapult) that was set up 12 years ago to provide support for UK Manufacturing through Innovation, Smart Manufacturing & Sustainable Manufacturing.

They provide a wide range of support services and projects with businesses of all sizes including Start-Ups and SMEs across all industry verticals.

They also provide a complimentary Line Walk as the initial way of engaging to understand business issues and problems and work with them to solve those problems through impact and positive outcomes

Digital Roadmapping Workshop Process

- One of the support catapults will be allocated to the business.
- The catapult will provide up to 8 days intervention with the company- this is where the real value is found.
- Diagnostic review takes place (in partnership with the business) to identify with business needs.
- Suppliers and solutions are recommended.
- Assistance through grant funding process, if required.



Additional Paths - Made Smarter West Midlands

Grants

- Eligible AME companies can access up to £20k worth of grant funding
- Companies must have gone through the road mapping workshops and identified a viable project in order to access the funding

Leadership and Management Training

- Eligible AME companies can access 30 hours of Made Smarter tailored training via our partners at CUS
 - 12.5 hours of facilitator led delivery.
 - 17.5 hours of self-learning.
 - Round table discussions.
- It is preferred (not essential)
 that companies go through the
 road mapping workshops and
 have identified a viable project
 in order to access the training
 programme



Results so far

- **403** businesses registered on programme.
- **86** grant projects approved and £1.4m issued.
- £94m GVA generated through the programme through £1.4m of grant funding.
