





## **JOINING THE PROGRAMME**




For High Growth Tech Businesses and Corporates seeking to Innovate.

# **PROGRAMME TIMELINE**






# ATTRACTING BUSINESSES TO THE PROGRAMME



The programme is open to businesses from across the globe.



Proactive in-country activity will be prioritised in markets where WMGC has presence and existing traction

## **HOW TO APPLY**



#### **Apply through the WMGC website.**



The business completes a simple form on the GGP webpage.

The GGP team contacts the business to talk through the programme and help them complete a full application.

If selected, the business will receive an offer to join the programme. This may contain some conditions such as obtaining VISAs.

The business selects which location they prefer and complete an agreement with the relevant Delivery Partner.

Once all conditions are met, the GGP team issues formal confirmation to start the programme with the agreed start date.

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**



Question	Answer
When does the programme start and end?	Applications open from early Feb (date to be confirmed) and close end March 2025. Companies will be able to land in the 5 Landing Hubs and receive support there from Feb24, but the full proposition will be not be available until May24.
What are the main components of the programme?	There are 3 layers to the programme:  1) Sponsored Deskspace for up to 3 employees for 9 months in one of 5 Innovation Centres across the region with full access to business support there  (2) access to sector-based support including relevant parts of the £33M WM Innovation Accelerator  (3) Access to bespoke support for international businesses coming in to the region.
What types of businesses are we targeting?	Tech and science businesses within four sectors: Future Mobility, Health Tech/Med Tech, Clean Tech and Digital Tech.

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**



Question	Answer
What maturity of businesses are we targeting?	While the programme is open to early-stage businesses, we are prioritising businesses with product looking to set up and scale their operations in the UK. We are also looking to attract corporates looking to establish innovation/R&D units in the West Midlands
What are the main components of the programme?	The workspace and associated support is fully sponsored by WMGC. Businesses may qualify for additional programmes and sponsored support from our partners.
How do business apply?	They complete an expression of interest form on the GGP webpage.

# **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**



Question	Answer
What happens at the end of the programme?	Businesses remain part of the GGP Community with regular events and activities to bring the diaspora network together to provide on going peer-peer support and access to other support programmes in the region.
How many businesses will be supported?	At least 40 businesses are planned to be supported on the programme.
How will you select businesses for the programme?	Given the comprehensive package we are offering, we have a tight selection process for this programme. We will prioritise high quality internationally owned tech businesses with a clear plan to expand into the UK and have a strong fit with what the WM has to offer. Businesses will need to have secured the appropriate VISAs etc. and make a commitment to having a presence in the region before they can join the programme.
