Supply Chain Transition Programme



- £1 million funded via the Commonwealth Games Legacy Fund
- The Supply Chain Transition Programme will help SMEs in the West Midlands diversify their customer base by winning new orders in growing areas of the economy.
- Delivery will be through workshops, 1-2-1 coaching, site visits, and meet the buyer events.
- Supply Chain Transition Programme is a BGWM regional delivery programme.







Supply Chain Transition Programme



- It covers three sectors:
 - Aerospace
 - Micromobility
 - Electric Light Vehicles and Very Light Rail
- It should appeal to companies which:
 - Have no foothold in the sector but with strong potential
 - Have a small foothold in the sector and looking to grow
 - Facing an uncertain future in their existing market segments
- These can be technology start-ups or established manufacturers/service providers
